Sweeping views of the Brisbane River and Kangaroo Point Cliffs create a stunning backdrop to Chartered Accountants Australia & New Zealand's (CA ANZ) new member lounge and training facility at level 13, Waterfront Place.

In partnership with Knight Frank Project Management and Building Consultancy, Gray Puksand delivered the 700sqm workspace which accommodates a member lounge, three training rooms, catering kitchen and workspace for 18 support staff.

A series of intensive briefing workshops with the client established the foundations for the function and performance requirements for each space.

These collaborative workshops drew out CA ANZ's desire for an impressive, yet humble member lounge and function space that is unique to Brisbane. In response to the brief, the design team integrated mirrored surfaces and a bespoke internal glazing system inspired by the façade glazing to allow the view to permeate the interior and create visual delight.

Bespoke Calacatta marble and brass joinery, bronze mirror and selected furniture from boutique Brisbane-based firm Derlot punctuate the workspace while training rooms hug the curved facade.

The success of these training rooms is the result of extensive coordination with the services engineers in order to meet the technological needs of the client. And in response to CAANZ's desire for a workplace that promotes the health and wellbeing of staff, sit to stand workstations provide an ergonomic solution for each staff member.

This is the second workspace Gray Puksand has completed for CAANZ and follows the completion of the Melbourne headquarters in 2016.
