

THE GREENS

TRANSFORMED FROM HISTORIC CLUB TO CONTEMPORARY MECCA FOR LOCAL FAMILIES AND BAREFOOT BOWLERS.



Gray Puksand's transformation of The Greens in North Sydney has seen the historic bowling club become a mecca for local families and people heading out for a spot of barefoot bowling and casual dinner or drinks with friends. Along with the architectural transformation, Gray Puksand extended the design brief to include a new name and new brand.

This neighbourhood venue is the second oldest bowls club in NSW and has a heritage overlay. It features a 1960's building with a soaring roof and two bowling greens on land with stunning harbour views. The third green is now an outdoor dining zone with adjacent garden.

With a tight budget to adhere to, the design team minimised structural change, renewed the amenities and sourced a historic photograph of the North Sydney Bowling Club as a cost effective way to treat a feature wall in the dining area. This feature along with found artefacts make the venue feel much loved and lived in.
